THANKS to City of Darwin Libraries, local students get free, anonymous, and instant homework help.

The yourtutor service is open from 3pm-8pm, Monday to Friday.

Students can connect online any time, as often as they like, in order to understand their homework questions.

The service enables students who are stuck with homework or assignment research to connect to qualified tutors for one-to-one guidance in English, maths, science, and assignment research.

Students can access yourtutor from library computers or online by using their library card number to log in through the library website,

There are no appointments necessary, and no registrations needed.

Lord Mayor Katrina Fong Lim said local school children deserve this kind of first class education service.

"We are pleased to give City of Darwin families the special benefits seen elsewhere around the country," she said.

Students connect online to a real, live person -- certified teachers, professional tutors, and graduates from Australian universities.

The tutors review specific homework and assignment questions with students online using features such as controlled chat and an interactive whiteboard.

Tutors don't tell students the answers, which makes your different to online learning tools that just provide pages of information.

The tutors are real people who guide students to find the solution so that they understand the answer at the end of each session, and how to work it out in future.
